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OVERVIEW

He understands the interplay between district court litigation and PTAB proceedings and works closely with district court teams to ensure alignment across forums. Sam has handled dozens of post-grant proceedings involving a broad range of technologies, including cybersecurity, wireless communications, process mining, networking, EDA software, and continuous glucose monitors.

Sam also has significant experience obtaining patents in technologies including combustion engines, footwear, aircraft, implantable medical devices, and winches.
